- ◆ Show respect for others in the classroom.

- ◆ Homework not completed when assigned due will receive only 50% of the scored grade (e.g. 90% on time = 45% when turned in late).

 - ◆ Take notes—it makes studying for unit tests and finals much easier!
 - ◆ Keep the classroom clean—pick up after yourself.
 - ◆ Keep a book cover on your textbook all year.
