

Spanish I and II Guidelines and Grading– Señora Patrick

Participation – Oral participation is *VERY* important in a language class, and all students will be expected to participate *willingly* each class day. A good attitude will go a long way! Points will be credited each day toward the participation grade. Absences affect participation.

Daily Work – No late work will be accepted. Homework, assignments and projects must be completed on time. Each student is requested to have a spiral bound notebook exclusively for Spanish. Notes should be taken and vocabulary should be recorded.

Projects – One per quarter

(Two will be class projects, and two will be individually chosen)

Ideas: Newspaper, Game Show, Learning Center, News Show, Biography, Cooking demonstration, Travel segment, Scrapbook style Country report, puppet show, live interview, Bulletin Board display, power point ad or infomercial, Radio Program

During the quarter when the students chooses a project, each student will be required to submit a project proposal by an announced deadline, with a finished project due 2 weeks before the end of the quarter.

Quizzes & Tests – *Quizzes may be announced or unannounced. Usually they are given based on current verbs and/or vocabulary. Tests are given at the end of each chapter. They are worth double the value of a quiz. There are oral and written portions to each chapter test.*
