They attended almost every fundraiser, helped at the rummage sales (even when it was physically very difficult), generously gave to special projects and the general operating fund and remembered MLHS in their estate plans.

Their family asked that their last estate gift be used for something special that would be a long-lasting tribute to their love of MLHS. This final gift was designated to be used for building improvement.

This generous gift is a Legacy of Love that is sincerely appreciated. It provides something special at MLHS that comes only because Lorenz and Ezurina remembered MLHS in their estate plans.

The Board of Directors authorized the finishing of the cement floors. The entry, lobby area, some halls and the bathrooms will soon have a PolyTek coating in royal blue and gray. Currently we have funds to cover a portion of the area that should be covered. For example to cover the cafeteria would cost almost \$3,000, the hallway from Room 101 down to the computer lab would be \$2,500, past the locker rooms would be about \$1,500.

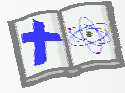
