

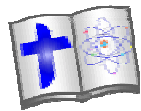
Cancellations

Transportation

- Since MLHS is located in the Fairmont school district, students living in the Fairmont district may ride the bus to MLHS at no cost. Students may have to transfer to another bus at Middle School.
- Students from the Truman district may ride the Truman bus to MLHS pending arrangements with Truman Bus Service.
- St. James Lutheran Elementary School, Northrop may provide transportation to their former students who are enrolled at MLHS. Arrangements should be made with their principal.
- Students come from Amboy, Ceylon, Estherville, Fairmont, Granada, Lake Crystal, Madelia, Northrop, Ormsby, St. James, Sherburn, Trimont, Truman, Vernon Center and Welcome.

Options

- Many families opt to car pool with other students traveling from their district. Families that provide their own transportation may request transportation reimbursement from their home school districts. This amount is calculated by how many miles you live from your district line. **Families must apply to their school district yearly for their reimbursement.**
- Students must register their vehicles with the school office.
- For the safety of everyone, students must obey parking lot rules.
